### Frequently asked questions about the dance show...

#### 1. What will my child wear?

We will provide all accessories and costumes needed. Depending on which class your child is in, you will pay a very small costume fee. You will provide a basic leotard, tights, jazz pants, skirts, shoes etc... Please do not worry about this now. We will give you all the information in April

#### 2. How long is the Show?

1:30 show is about 45 mins.  
3:00 show is about 1 hour  
5:30 show is about 1-1 1/2 hrs.  
8:00 show-2 hours

#### 3. What show is my child in?

**1:30-** All Pre-Ballet I/II ballet/tap students Ages 2 1/2 to 5yrs  
**3:00-** All Ballet/Tap/Jazz I/II students ages 5yrs. to 7yrs.  
**5:30-** All 8-13yr olds

**8:00-** All Weds. 10-13yrs Pre-Pointe and Dance III,  
Sat 11:45 Hip-Hop and all Advanced classes.

#### 5. How do we get tickets and how much are they?

Tickets can be purchased the week before the show. General Admission is \$10.00 Child (under 10) & Sr. Citizen \$7.00 \*Your performing child is free.
